Question 1

Community HealthChoices (CHC) has officially been operating since January 1, 2018 or 4 months, can each one of the participants give a brief explanation of what their initial thoughts are of the program?





Question 2

Can the participants please explain their experience with being paid timely by the Medicaid Managed Care Organizations (MCO's)? Are there any MCO's that are not paying timely?





Question 3

Have you had any issues with submitting claims? Do you have any suggestions on how facilities can prepare themselves to be able to submit claims?





Question 4

Have there been any specific issues with the different billing systems for the three individual MCO's?





Question 5

Have there been any billing/payment issues relative to patient pay deductions, Medicare coinsurance and other medical expense deductions?





Question 6

Can the panel please explain their experience with Appendix 4 payments, and the nursing home assessment program payments?





Question 7

Has anyone tried to negotiate the terms of a contract with a MCO? Has anyone had success in getting the terms changed? How have you dealt with payments that are now rolled into the rate such as DSH payments?





Question 8

How has the Eligibility Verification System been working? Is the system updated timely? Is the appropriate information in the system to determine eligibility? Is the MCO information correct?





Question 9

We have heard that there have been issues with transportation in the southwest, such as: trips being cancelled at the last minute, drivers not showing up, and participants not receiving needed assistance to the door of the building. Has anyone on the panel had any transportation issues they would be willing to discuss?





Question 10

Have MCO's made any onsite visits? What was the nature and reason of the visit? Have they been helpful with billing and/or clinical documentation?





Question 11

How has your experience working with the Service Coordinators in your buildings been during CHC's initial phase? Any issues?





Question 12

Has anyone had communication with the Independent Enrollment Broker (IEB)? Has the IEB made any onsite visits to assist with the eligibility process?





Question 13

When analyzing other States, and their experiences, it was noted that in some cases nursing home eligibility denial rates have increased. Also, it was noted that some MCO's were offering incentives to potential members to sign up with their MCO, and/or only selecting the healthiest members to join their plan. Although, it is very early in the process, has there been any evidence of these items taking place?
